

## U.S. Secretary of Transportation Elaine L. Chao Announces \$653.2 Million in Emergency Relief for Road and Bridge Repairs

Thursday, February 27, 2020

WASHINGTON – U.S. Secretary of Transportation Elaine L. Chao announced the U.S. Department of Transportation’s (USDOT) Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) will award \$653.2 million in Emergency Relief (ER) funds to help 37 states, as well as Washington, D.C., Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands, make repairs to roads and bridges damaged by storms, floods, mudslides and other unexpected events.
